
How long have you been experiencing uncontrolled pain?






Where is your pain located?










Have you tried any of the ff in order to control your pain?






Have you ever had a pacemaker implant?

Summary and Conclusion

- 92% of leads have been diagnosed with chronic pain by a medical professional
- 77% of leads have been experiencing uncontrolled pain for 2 years or more
- 38% of leads say the pain is in their arms, 69% said their legs, 25% said torso
- 69% of leads say the pain is in their back, while 21% said their pain is located on their head
- 30% of leads are seeing a primary care physician, 32% are seeing a pain specialist and 26% say their pain is not being managed
- In terms of pain scale, 9% rank their pain at a 10, 7% at a 9, 32% at 8, 28% at 7, 15% at 6, 3% at 5, but no leads ranked their pain at 4 or lower
- 85% have tried prescription pain medication, 63% say they've tried OTC meds, 59% have tried lifestyle change, 32% have tried massage, 21% have tried acupuncture, 22% have tried nerve block, 28% have tried physical therapy, 5% have tried surgery
- O leads said they were not frustrated with their current treatment effectiveness, 20% said they were very frustrated and 41% said they were extremely frustrated
- 47% say they would be willing to pay less than \$150 per treatment, 5% said \$15-\$200 and 3% said they'd pay \$550-\$600 per treatment
